TAA40104 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment

Electro Jobs is now offering training in the national industry qualification Certificate IV in Training and Assessment in partnership with the ACTU ECC's registered training organisation (TOID 4141). The course is specifically for ETU members working in the building and construction industry in Queensland and will enable successful participants to become a qualified industry trainer and/or assessor.

The training program is made up of workshop sessions, self directed learning, mentoring support and practical work based assignments. Participants are expected to have reasonable writing, communication and computer skills in order to complete the program.



Topics covered include:

- Understanding the vocational education & training system
- Ensuring health & safety in the learning environment
- Foster and promote inclusive learning practices
- Using training packages to design learning and assessment strategies
- Designing and developing training programs that lead to national industry qualifications and accredited courses
- Facilitating group based learning
- Coaching and mentoring individual learning
- Facilitating work based learning
- Planning and undertaking competency based assessment
- Designing and developing assessment tools and participating in assessment validation

Assessment activities are designed around practical work based outcomes, looking specifically at the development of training and assessment for post trade training in the construction industry.
